## **Basis Of Property**

## We will need:

- 1. Settlement sheets when the lot / building was purchased.
- 2. Settlement sheet from any refinances.
- 3. If inherited, we will need the appraised value on date of death or on which inheritance taxes were paid.

List the cost of all improvements to the home. **Please note** this is not a complete list of all the possible improvements you could make to a home. The general idea is to start on the outside of the home, then go to the exterior surface, then go to the inside of the home. Include all improvements after purchase that will go with the home when sold or converted.
